ETI INSPECTION JUNE 2018



- Saintfield High School has worked purposefully on streamlining the effective delivery of pastoral care provision within the academic needs of the children, reflected in the strategic appointment of a 'Study for Success Co-ordinator'.
- A wide selection of pupils spoke enthusiastically and positively about the benefits of the mental health and well-being programmes and how these programmes assist with their learning and academic progress through the school.
- It has been notable that the school's rate of attendance has been consistently above the Northern Ireland average.
- Pupils were appreciative of their tracking and target-setting which helps them identify areas in their learning where they require extra support and guidance.
- Parents and carers indicated their approval of the school's systems for identifying and targeting potential, and the high priority given to the pupils' emotional well-being.
- During the inspection, the school provided evidence that the arrangements for safeguarding pupils reflect the guidance from the Department of Education.

CONCLUSION:

Saintfield High School continues to demonstrate a **high level** of capacity to identify and bring about improvement in the interest of all pupils.

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
