### **NOTES**

- 1 If you have no examination you do not need to come to school but should revise at home.

- 3 If your exam does not last for the full session you will revise in the hall first and then sit the exam. It is **your responsibility** to bring adequate revision materials to the exam hall. No pupil leaves the hall during a session.
